Parking, pick-up, drop-off

Following on from my communication last week, please could I remind parents of the following drop-off and pick-up rules:

We ask that all parents:

- Correctly park their cars without blocking any driveways.
- Refrain from performing 3-point turns in the road / using drive-ways to turn around
- Accompany the children to the gates.

I must stress the importance of the last point and argue that it is not constructive to watch your child cross the road/ walk up the street *from your car*. Watching will not prevent a road accident nor stop your child from being hit by a car crossing a driveway. The street is very busy and our children are for the most part far too short to be easily seen by careless drivers. Mrs Gada was on the gate this week and was sadly witness to several near misses. It only takes a fraction of a second for a tragedy to occur and I must ask that you put the safety of the children first and take the few short minutes necessary to accompany them to the gates.
